6.-10. year old pupils

The school's Christmas tree picked up

Objectives:

- That students enjoy the outdoors throughout the school day.
- That students learn about forestry and the cultivation of spruce trees in Iceland.
- That students find diverse ways to use Christmas trees when Christmas time is over.

Materials Needed:

- Bus
- Pupils have warm clothes due to weather
- School lunch

Lesson Structure

Discussion among pupils and teacher

Discussion in class about the trip and its purpose

Field trip

Students go to the school's friendly forest in the morning. A forestry employee welcomes them and takes them on a walk through the forest. During the hike, the students are taught about forestry and the cultivation of conifers in Iceland. Students choose a tree that will decorate the school during Advent. A lumberjack cuts down a tree and helps students put it on a cart that takes it to school.

Students draw a comic sequence about the field trip

Work during lessons

Students prepare Christmas decorations from recyclable materials. Examples of materials include wood from last year's Christmas tree, old CDs, cones, make a Christmas star from branches.

Work in lessons after Christmas

The teacher talks to the students about how the Christmas tree can be used in the future. Students come up with ideas.

Examples of ideas

- Use materials in wood carving
- Use materials to make Christmas decorations for next year.
- Use materials for firewood.

Lesson Assessment: /

- Student self-assessment. Students submit a self-assessment to the teacher on how the work went and whether they knew all the items that were being worked on.
